Myanmar Evangelism

We at Truth For The World are blessed to have many faithful congregations and individuals working with us in teaching all nations. And we are blessed to see many souls learning the truth of God's Word. The following letter came to us recently from a man in Myanmar who just a few years back came to the knowledge of the truth after he found our website and took our Bible Correspondence Course. Since that time, he has been a tireless servant working to teach others what he himself has learned. He continues to seek faithful preachers to come and teach them a deeper understanding of God's Word. We are now in the process of raising funds for a trip this fall to go and work with him and the congregation that he established in Tachileik. This letter, I pray, is an encouragement to you, our dear supporters and volunteers, that together our work is bearing much fruit.

Dear Brother Kevin Graves,

How is your life and family there? I hope that all the things will going well by the grace of God. I pray for you and all your works there.

We have 7 news Christians at the border of Laos and Myanmar the village name called Nam Won. This village is 74 miles a way from Tachileik.

There is a christian name Abel. He become a christian in 2014 after Bible studied with me for 3 full nights. After he came back to his home from Tachileik, he teaches the Bible to his wife but his wife did not like the new testament teaching and worship. In 2015 Abel invited me to come and teach the Bible to his wife so, I and my wife came to his house and studied the bible with his family for only one night. His wife said that I will invite you to teach the Bible in some day.

Last week Abel and his wife invited me to come and teach the Bible to the village for 4 days. When I arrived to their village some people were waiting to have Bible classes with me. Our Bible classes started on 13 and ended on 16. I taught them the 3 dispensations of the Bible (what you taught us in Tachileik) and how to received the remission of sins.

There was a lot of questions were raising concerning with Baptism. Most of them were taught and believed the wrong teaching that Believe and Saved and baptism is not necessary for saved. I opened the book of Mark 16:15-16, Mt 28: 19 and the book of Acts. Some old men still said that we already baptized and no need to do again. Some want to baptize for the remission of their sins but much hesitate. There are 7 young men and women gladly decided to baptized for the remission of their sins and they did on last Sunday morning.

Abel and new 7 Christians will gather together and start worship at Abel's house in every Sunday. I teach them how to bake a bread for the Lord's supper and how to start the new testament worship. Abel will preach and teach on Sunday and I need to visit them at least once a month. I pray for the new Christians to be strong in the Truth as they are living among wrong teaching.

Some villagers also invited me to come and teach the Bible again. During our Bible classes I provide for lunch for 4 days. They are very happy for this is the first time they heard the Truth.

We do know that this is the best thing to growing fast for the Lord's church here is to produces many good and faithful preachers. To have many good and faithful preachers we need a good preaching school. Therefore we have a big plan to start preaching school for two years. We will accept 10 students for the first year. And we will accept another 10 students in the next year. So, we will have 20 students in every years. The planning is 10 students will finish each year and then 10 new students will be accepted in the each years.



We will start teaching to our preaching school from the course one of Truth for the World what I have studied. This is very good to study for the new students. We will surely need a simple Bible study guide from Genesis to Revelations. If you have some send them to us please.

Thank you very much for your prayers for the Lord's work in Myanmar. I and all Christians here pray for you in daily. We are longing to see you and with all your family in the month of November. We pray for your missionary journey to Myanmar.
